



**THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SALE OF RAFFLE TICKETS SHALL APPLY TO
THE 47TH ANNUAL ALBERTA ELKS FOUNDATION RAFFLE**

1. Raffle tickets may not be sold to any person under the age of 18 years.
2. Raffle ticket sellers must advise ticket buyers **NOT** to write the name of a person under the age of 18 on the ticket due to the requirements of the Public Trustee Act.
3. All prizes, as listed with the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission and as listed on all tickets, shall be awarded on the dates listed. There shall be no substitutions or cash in lieu of the listed prizes. All prizes will be new. All draws shall be as per listed with one winner being chosen per prize.
4. There is no restriction on the participation of members or their families in purchasing tickets, with exception of the Provincial Raffle Chairman, who may not purchase or have their name on any tickets in the draw.
5. The draws will be conducted with 3 members of the public and 2 members of the Alberta Elks Foundation will be present to witness each draw. A person who does not have a ticket or a share in a ticket will make the draw.
6. Early bird draws will be made at the Stavely Elks Lodge #112; in the Stavely Community Centre 5001 - 50 Ave, Stavely, AB T0L 1Z0 and will be made as follows:
 - I. \$500.00 value Fas Gas Certificate (s) on _ Tuesday, February 16, 2016
 - II. \$750.00 value Fas Gas Certificate (s) on _ Tuesday, March 15, 2016
 - III. \$750.00 value Fas Gas Certificate (s) on _ Tuesday, April 19, 2016
7. All "Early Bird" winning tickets will be returned to the drum to be eligible for any subsequent draws.
8. Final prizes will be awarded on the final draw date of Saturday June 11th, 2016 at The Hanna Community Centre, 503 - 5th Avenue West, Hanna Ab. T0J 1P0.
9. Prizes will be drawn in the following order and the drawn tickets will not be returned to the drum:
 - I. \$30,000.00 dollars cash
 - II. \$10,000.00 dollars cash

III. Groceries for a Year @ \$100.00/week plus 3 Bonus amounts of \$100.00. Value \$5,500.

IV. \$1,500.00 in FAS GAS Certificates

10. Notification of all winners shall be by telephone, double registered mail or personal contact.
11. No extra tickets will be drawn at the time of the draw for major prizes.
12. Should any prize not be claimed within one year of the draw date, with the approval of the Alberta Gaming Commission, the prize may be donated to a charity selected by the Alberta Elks Foundation (e.g. The Institute for Stuttering Treatment and Research).
13. It shall be the responsibility of the winners of the major prize to take possession of said major prize from the current Raffle Chairman of the Alberta Elks Foundation.
14. There shall be no refund of sold tickets.
15. Sold tickets must be returned to the Raffle Chairman by express post or courier or in person no later than **the first of the month in which the Early Bird Draw(s) occurs.** All sold and unsold books must be returned to the Raffle Chairman by express post, courier or in person no later than **two (2) weeks prior to the Final Draw** so that any lost tickets may be traced if required.
16. There will be no draw date extension or cancellation applied for except under extreme cases. If the ticket sales do not reach \$110,000.00 by June 1st of the year of the raffle, an application to extend or cancel the raffle may be considered.
17. **Lodges that have lost ticket books throughout the year may be charged with all or a portion of the advertising costs in local papers prior to final draw as per Alberta Gaming Commission instructions.** Advertising in the applicable newspapers will be arranged, ordered and paid for by the Raffle Chairman and deducted from the commission for the lodges that have lost ticket books.
18. In the event a winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, the Alberta Elks Foundation shall award the prize to only one of the individuals identified on the ticket. The Alberta Elks Foundation and Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission are not responsible for any disputes, which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
19. Groceries for a year is: \$100.00 per week for 52 weeks, plus 3 bonus amounts of \$100.00 to be given at the request of the winner at chosen times throughout the year. (e.g.: Christmas, New Years, Easter, Thanksgiving, etc.). Gift certificates will be purchased and issued to the winner from and outlet of the winner's choice in their shopping area. (e.g.: IGA, Sobeys, Safeway, Extra Foods, etc.).
20. If more than one name appears on a ticket, and one or more of them has been scratched out, proof of purchase of the remaining name must be supplied to validate the ticket. If such a ticket is drawn and proof of purchase cannot be made, then the ticket shall be declared VOID and removed from the draw and another ticket shall be drawn for the prize involved.
